Car-PC: When visions engender innovation

Hymer motorhomes already provide a wide range of electronic entertainment and information processing systems for use while travelling. In tomorrow's motorhome, the Hymer-Innovision, all these possibilities are combined and realized in a single, groundbreaking system: the Car-PC. This move demonstrates how bold visions engender true innovation.

A computer housed in the storage area of the motorhome is the heart of this Hymer multimedia centre and controls 15 different functions. They can be accessed and operated using an 8.4-inch TFT display either in the cab or in the sleeping area. A new LED display with infinitely variable regulation of brightness and illuminated keys is easy to use and is guaranteed to work from -20 to +80 degrees. In addition, connections are provided for two 17- and 19-inch TFT monitors. All the monitors are securely mounted for swivel movement using the Hymer-specific monitor holder.

Apart from the standard entertainment and information media such as television (with remote control), radio and internet via satellite, video recorder and DVD player, the Car-PC lives up to its name by providing functions the mobile PC user is familiar with from home: text processing, spreadsheet analysis, data processing and file manager functions, e-mail and image editing. Also integrated are a DVD burner and a card reader housed together with the CD and DVD drives in the compartment next to the TFT display.

Whether for enjoying music, watching a film of one's choice or viewing holiday snapshots, the multifunctional Hymer media centre transforms the

motorhome user into a master of ceremonies who puts together his own entertainment programme. What is more, text and spreadsheet programs enable him to draft, edit and save itineraries, brain waves, calculations or letters.

On top of all these features, the Car-PC includes a satellite navigation device for safe, stress-free travel as well as regular and automatic teleservice of the entire system. The spectrum of multimedia capabilities is complemented by the digital speedometer replacing the standard display in the basic vehicle.

Initial plans are to launch the Car-PC in January 2009 as an optional extra for the Hymermobil B-Class SL range. The new system will be presented at the Caravan Salon in Duesseldorf, Hymer Hall Number 17, from 30 August to 7 September 2008.
